Healthcare – Electrocardiography (EKG) Technicians & Phlebotomist

This in-depth course will train you to apply, monitor, and measure electrocardiography tests in a supportive learning environment. You will learn how to take blood samples from patients, proper labeling, and a wide range of tests used for diagnosis. Key subjects, such as CPR, measuring basic vital signs, patient identification, and safety are also included.

Business – Human Resource Specialist

Prepare for a career in human resources where you will work for a company to find, screen, recruit, and train job applicants, as well as administer employee-benefit programs. This course explores the foundational aspects of HR, including human resource laws, hiring disciplines, and labor relations.

Education – Child Development Associate / Home Day Care

The Child Development Associate (CDA) credential is the most widely recognized credential in early care and education and is the first and most important step you can take to advance your career. Candidates who earn the credential are well prepared to foster the social, emotional, physical and cognitive growth of young children. The credential leads to employment opportunities in Head Start, pre-K, infant-toddler, family child care, and home visitor programs.

Technology – Data Security

With the continuous emergence of cybersecurity threats against companies and government institutions, organizations are more focused than ever on recruiting and retaining information security professionals who can protect corporate assets and prevent criminal activities. Take and pass the CompTIA Security+ exam, which will help you to pursue professional careers in cybersecurity.

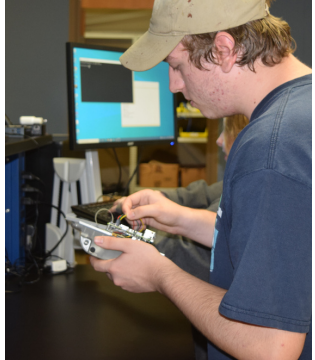
Participant Fees
