HELPFUL TIPS FOR APPLYING TO GRANTS

○ Preparation

- ✓ Review funding opportunity purpose and scope of work
- ✓ Eligible applicants
- ✓ Available funding and award information
- ✓ Scoring criteria
- ✓ Accompanying attachments

HELPFUL TIPS FOR APPLYING TO GRANTS

○ Timeliness

- ✓ Review application due date and time
- ✓ Set timeframe to complete all application requests
- ✓ Submit early to avoid technology errors

○ Completeness

- ✓ Confirm required documents and questions addressed
- ✓ Concise and specific responses
